Nature of Work

Under the direction of the Recreation Supervisor-Athletics, this position is responsible for leading and teaching skills pertaining to specified recreation area, and supervise participants safely in a public recreational facility.

Essential Functions

- Must possess a highly defined focus towards both internal and external guest service
- Explains and demonstrates use of apparatus and equipment or skill
- Explains and demonstrate principles, techniques, and methods of regulating movement of body, hands, and feet to achieve proficiency
- Observes during practice to detect and correct mistakes
- Explains and enforces safety rules and regulations
- May manage classes of children by keeping attention
- Find substitutes for classes when not available
- Communicates with participants, parents, coordinator(s) and supervisor as necessary
- Attends all required meetings and trainings
- Sets up, cleans up, and moves equipment for proper class or party
- Checks equipment and space for proper safety
- Report accidents and injuries that occur during class
- Administer first-aid as necessary

Management & Supervisory Duties

Oversees participants in class.

Illustrative Examples of Duties

- Set up/clean up for daily circuits or classes.
- Record attendance and/or progression of participants in classes.

Skills

Moderate verbal and written communication skills.

Knowledge

Knowledge of fundamentals and instructional methods of course being taught.

Abilities

- Ability to instruct participants properly and safely to reach goal.
- Ability to perform work in an indoor environment with frequent interruptions and distractions.





Required Training, Experience & Qualifications

- CPR/AED, and First-Aid Certification, or have the ability to obtain within six-months (6) of employment
- 1 2 years' experience instructing tennis and fundamentals
